During this year's show, we'll be using this Hall again for press conferences and a panel discussion. Follow posted signs or ask us to point you the right direction!

The Media Center is located in the Walnut Center on the fairgrounds. You are welcome to use the Media Center throughout Expo. The media room is equipped with wireless connectivity, telephone lines and a printer/copier. This is for working media only. Refreshments will be available throughout the day in the media room.
