World Pork Expo media credentials are required for entry into press conferences and the media room. Media personnel are to enter through Gate 9 at the Iowa State Fairgrounds. Name badges and parking permits are required to enter.

The Media Center is located in the Walnut Center on the fairgrounds. You are welcome to use the Media Center throughout Expo. The media room is equipped with wireless connectivity and a printer/copier. This is for working media only. Refreshments will be available throughout the day in the media room. **Please note that the Media wi-fi is not available outside of the Media Center, so we recommend bringing a hotspot with you if needed.**
